

25 Petitions for Hearts That Are Burning for Christ Walk to Our Lady's Grotto – 54 Mile Walk

1 We pray for our Church: that Pope Francis, Bishops, Priests, Deacons, Religious Sisters, and all of our faithful will exercise the gifts of The Holy Spirit so that fear will be conquered through Christ's love during this time and that we may be God's instruments as our Mother Mary intercedes for all of us to soon join again for the celebration of Mass and reception of the sacraments.

7 We pray for all souls that have been recently lost, from the coronavirus and all other ways; that their souls will rest in the peace of Christ.

8 We pray for all families and friends who have lost loved ones during this pandemic, that they will be consoled by the promises of Christ, particularly during this Easter season.

9 We pray for all who are facing so many temptations during this time; particularly for our youth and all others without their regular routines spending so much time in front of electronic screens: that the Blessed Mother will reside in their hearts and homes.

10 We pray for all of those who are alone, frightened, discouraged, and tempted to despair: that they will take the hand of the Blessed Mother and grow in faith, trust, and the inner peace of Christ in their hearts.

11 We pray for those parents without childcare and for parents in general who are facing so much stress right now - that they will make time and silence with God an increased priority, thus allowing them to receive many graces.

12 We pray for the intentions of those supporting the 'Hearts That Are Burning Walk' and 'The Neighborhood Walk'; also, for blessings, health and stamina for Fr. Dan, Fr. Mario, Fr. Shaun and Fr. Ebuka throughout the 54 mile walk.

13 We pray for our priests that they will be inspired to live out their vocations to the fullest, relying more on the graces received upon their ordination, especially during this difficult time.

14 We pray for all the children and adults at the Mustard Seed Communities in Jamaica and their caretakers and for all who provide financial, physical and spiritual support for the Mustard Seed Communities in Jamaica.

15 We pray for all of the disabled throughout the world and their caretakers; that a prayer life will be developed modeled after the mustard seed program.

21 We pray for an increase in faith of those who had to postpone the reception of their sacraments – Holy Orders, First Communions, Confirmations and Marriages – that, both, their understanding of and faith in the teachings of the Church will increase during this time.

22 We give thanks for the protection of our Military, Police and all first responders and we pray that St. Michael the Archangel will intercede and provide protection for them.

23 We pray for all students, their teachers, and parents who have become substitute teachers, that they will rely upon the authority of Christ to teach their children and that many of their homes may become the first seminaries for future vocations.

24 We pray for those suffering financial hardship due to job loss and for all of the poor in our communities, that they will see the Light of Christ in their suffering and that their needs will be met.

25 We pray for families, now "quarantined" together, that, as they experience pressures from old wounds, they will pray the rosary together and that, through our Lady's intercession, this will be a time of beauty and grace.
